**Somerset County - Code of Public Local Laws - Cross-References and  
Corrections**

This bill corrects cross-references to the Annotated Code of Maryland in the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset County and updates incorrect references to the County Treasurer to the Supervisor of Tax Collection in the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset County.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** None. The bill does not materially affect Somerset County operations or finances.

**Analysis**

**Current Law/Background:** Chapter 194 of 2013 abolished the elected office of County Treasurer in Somerset County and transferred all functions and responsibilities to the Somerset County Supervisor of Tax Collection. The Somerset County commissioners must appoint a Supervisor of Tax Collection who is required to work with the Tax Collection Office as part of the Finance Department under the direction of the Finance Director.

The Somerset County budget includes \$296,996 for salaries, expenses, and benefits for the County Tax Collection Office.
