AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with "in" in line 1 down through "COUNTY," in line 2; in line 3, strike "§ 21–104.2" and substitute "§§ 21–104.2 THROUGH 21–104.4"; strike beginning with "A" in line 4 down through "(14)" in line 7; and in line 9, strike "(15)" and substitute "(14)".

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 12 on page 3 through line 5 on page 4, inclusive, and substitute:

- (1) May operate the golf cart only:
- (i) On a county highway on which the maximum posted speed limit does not exceed 35 miles per hour;
 - (ii) Between dawn and dusk; and

- (2) Shall keep the golf cart as far to the right of the roadway as feasible; and
 - (3) Shall possess a valid driver's license.

 - (3) SHALL POSSESS A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE.
- (B) THE TOWN GOVERNMENT MAY DESIGNATE THE HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF VIENNA ON WHICH A PERSON MAY OPERATE A GOLF CART.".
