AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after the first "a" insert "<u>certain</u>"; in line 8, after "a" insert "<u>certain</u>"; and in line 9, after "circumstances;" insert "<u>requiring a certain financial</u> <u>institution to adopt a certain record retention policy for audio recordings;</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 19 and 24, in each instance, after "INSTITUTION" insert "<u>THAT ACCEPTS DEPOSITS IN THE STATE</u>"; and in line 29, strike "INTERCEPTION" and substitute "<u>COMMUNICATION</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 5, strike ", ON WRITTEN REQUEST,"; and in line 7, after "INVESTIGATION" insert ", ON WRITTEN REQUEST, TO ASSIST IN AN ONGOING <u>CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION OF A ROBBERY, UNDER § 3–402 OR § 3–403 OF THE</u> <u>CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, OR ANY OTHER CRIMINAL ACT CARRIED OUT IN</u> <u>FURTHERANCE OF A ROBBERY.</u>

(C) <u>A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION THAT INTERCEPTS AND RECORDS ORAL</u> COMMUNICATIONS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL ADOPT A RECORD RETENTION POLICY THAT REQUIRES THE DESTRUCTION OF AN AUDIO RECORDING WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE DATE RECORDING IS MADE".
