<u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 501</u> (Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after "Fund;" insert "<u>requiring the Department of Natural</u> <u>Resources to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain</u> <u>date; providing for the termination of this Act;</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 6 and 23, in each instance, strike "STATE-OPERATED" and substitute "STATE-MANAGED".

On page 3, in lines 10 and 12, in each instance, strike "STATE-OPERATED" and substitute "STATE-MANAGED".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 15, strike "**\$3,000,000**" and substitute "**\$1,000,000**"; after line 21, insert:

"<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That, on or before December 1, 2021, the Department of Natural Resources shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on:

(1) the status of the State Lakes Protection and Restoration Fund;

(2) the amount of money expended from the Fund for the protection or restoration of State–owned or State–managed lakes;

(3) the costs incurred in administering the Fund; and

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(4) any recommendations for the Fund.";

in line 22, strike "2." and substitute "<u>3.</u>"; and in line 23, after the period insert "<u>It shall</u> remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 2022, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
