AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 963  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, after the semicolon insert “requiring the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board to maintain a certain office at a certain location;”; and in line 30, after the semicolon insert “providing for certain considerations when establishing classifications for new employees;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in line 9, strike “and”; and in line 10, after “(8)” insert “TO MAINTAIN AN OFFICE IN BALTIMORE CITY, THAT IS ACCESSIBLE BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCEPTING CLAIMS AND PROVIDING ASSISTANCE ON FILING CLAIMS; AND

**(9)**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 13, in line 2, after the period insert “In order to ensure the equitable treatment of new employees, the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention shall consider the current job classifications and rights provided to current employees when establishing classifications for new employees.”.
