AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 184
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 16, strike “submit” and substitute “publish”; in lines 16 and 17, strike “to the County Council for publication”; in line 17, strike “County Council’s” and substitute “Inspector General’s”; in line 22, strike “County Council” and substitute “Inspector General”; and in line 23, strike “County Council’s” and substitute “Inspector General’s”.

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with the first “County” in line 30 on page 1 down through “system” in line 1 on page 2 and substitute “county board and Chief Executive Officer”.

On page 2, in line 2, strike “County Council” and substitute “county board and Chief Executive Officer”; in line 14, after the first semicolon insert “requiring the Inspector General to submit to the Prince George’s County Board of Education a certain budget proposal each year; requiring the county board to include in its annual budget proposal certain amounts for the Office;”; and in line 15, after “Act;” insert “transferring the functions, powers, and duties of the Office of Internal Audit of the Prince George’s County school system to the Office of the Inspector General on a certain date; requiring that certain employees who are transferred to the Office of the Inspector General be transferred without any diminution of their rights;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in lines 23 and 24, strike “**SUBMIT WRITTEN REPORTS TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL FOR PUBLICATION ON THE COUNTY COUNCIL’S WEBSITE**” and substitute “**PUBLISH ON THE OFFICE’S WEBSITE, IN A READILY AVAILABLE LOCATION:**”

1. PERIODIC REPORTS THAT SUMMARIZE THE ACTIVITIES, FINDINGS, RECOMMENDATIONS, AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE OFFICE; AND

2. ANY OFFICIAL WRITTEN COMMENTS OR RESPONSES OFFERED BY THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM ADMINISTRATION WITH ANY REPORT PUBLISHED BY THE OFFICE”.

On page 6, strike in their entirety lines 4 through 10, inclusive.

On page 7, in line 6, strike “COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM” and substitute “COUNTY BOARD AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER”; in line 10, strike “COUNTY COUNCIL” and substitute “COUNTY BOARD AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER”; in line 19, strike “COUNTY COUNCIL” and substitute “COUNTY BOARD AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER”; and in line 22, strike “COUNTY COUNCIL” and substitute “COUNTY BOARD AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER”.

On page 8, after line 19, insert:

“(J) (1) EACH YEAR THE INSPECTOR GENERAL SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COUNTY BOARD A PROJECTED BUDGET FOR THE OFFICE FOR THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR.

(2) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL INCLUDE IN THE COUNTY BOARD’S ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET PROPOSAL THE AMOUNTS RECOMMENDED BY THE INSPECTOR GENERAL FOR THE OFFICE FOR THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the functions, powers, and duties of the Office of Internal Audit of the Prince George’s County school system shall

be transferred to the Office of the Inspector General of the school system on the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all employees who are transferred to the Office of the Inspector General of the Prince George's County school system as a result of this Act shall be transferred on the effective date of this Act without any diminution of their rights, including collective bargaining rights, benefits, or employment or retirement status.”;

and in line 20, strike “2.” and substitute “4.”.
