AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1295 (Third Reading File Bill)

On page 1, in line 4, after "of" insert "<u>altering the definition of "qualified</u> <u>distressed county</u>" by altering certain income levels in the definition and renaming it to <u>be "Tier I county"</u>;".

On page 2, in line 10, after "Section" insert "<u>1–101,</u>".

On page 4, after line 11, insert:

"<u>1–101.</u>

- (a) In this division the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) <u>"County" means a county of the State or Baltimore City.</u>
- (c) <u>"Department" means the Department of Commerce.</u>

(d) <u>"Person" means an individual, receiver, trustee, guardian, personal</u> representative, fiduciary, representative of any kind, partnership, firm, association, corporation, or other entity.

(e) (1) "Qualified distressed county" means a county with:

(i) an average rate of unemployment for the most recent 24month period for which data are available that exceeds 150% of the average rate of unemployment for the State during that period;

(ii) an average rate of unemployment for the most recent 24-

month period for which data are available that exceeds the average rate of unemployment in the State by at least 2 percentage points; or

(iii) an average per capita personal income for the most recent 24-month period for which data are available that is equal to or less than 67% of the average per capita personal income for the State during that period.

(2) "Qualified distressed county" includes a county that:

(i) <u>no longer meets either criterion stated in paragraph (1) of this</u> <u>subsection; but</u>

(ii) has met at least one of the criteria at some time during the preceding 24-month period.]

[(f)] (E) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Commerce.

[(g)] (F) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, "state" means:

(i) <u>a state, possession, territory, or commonwealth of the United</u>

<u>States; or</u>

- (ii) the District of Columbia.
- (2) When capitalized, "State" means Maryland.

(G) (1) "TIER I COUNTY" MEANS A COUNTY WITH:

(I) AN AVERAGE RATE OF UNEMPLOYMENT FOR THE MOST RECENT 24–MONTH PERIOD FOR WHICH DATA ARE AVAILABLE THAT EXCEEDS

150% OF THE AVERAGE RATE OF UNEMPLOYMENT FOR THE STATE DURING THAT PERIOD;

(II) AN AVERAGE RATE OF UNEMPLOYMENT FOR THE MOST RECENT 24–MONTH PERIOD FOR WHICH DATA ARE AVAILABLE THAT EXCEEDS THE AVERAGE RATE OF UNEMPLOYMENT FOR THE STATE BY AT LEAST 2 PERCENTAGE POINTS; OR

(III) <u>A MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME FOR THE MOST RECENT</u> 24–MONTH PERIOD FOR WHICH DATA ARE AVAILABLE THAT IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN 75% OF THE MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME FOR THE STATE DURING THAT PERIOD.

(2) <u>"TIER I COUNTY" INCLUDES A COUNTY THAT:</u>

(I) <u>NO LONGER MEETS ANY OF THE CRITERIA STATED IN</u> PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION; BUT

(II) HAS MET AT LEAST ONE OF THE CRITERIA AT SOME TIME DURING THE PRECEDING 24–MONTH PERIOD.".

On page 7, in line 1, strike "IN" and substitute "FOR".
