AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 247

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “requiring” in line 6 down through “location;” in line 7; in line 11, after “Prevention;” insert “requiring the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board to maintain a certain office at a certain location;”; and strike beginning with “providing” in line 20 down through “location;” in line 22.

On page 2, in line 9, after “units;” insert “providing for certain considerations when establishing classifications for new employees;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in line 16, strike “and”; and in line 17, after “(8)” insert “TO MAINTAIN AN OFFICE IN BALTIMORE CITY, THAT IS ACCESSIBLE BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCEPTING CLAIMS AND PROVIDING ASSISTANCE ON FILING CLAIMS; AND

(9)”.

On page 7, in line 18, strike “**THE PHYSICIAN OR HOSPITAL IS**” and substitute “**QUALIFIED HOSPITAL HEALTH CARE PERSONNEL AND THE HOSPITAL ARE**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 12, in lines 19 and 20, strike beginning with the semicolon in line 19 down through “City” in line 20; and in line 29, after “the” insert “fiscal year 2020”.

On page 13, strike beginning with “New” in line 9 down through “service” in line 12 and substitute “In order to ensure the equitable treatment of new employees, the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention shall consider the current job

classifications and rights provided to current employees when establishing classifications for new employees"; strike in their entirety lines 13 through 15, inclusive; and in lines 16, 22, 30, and 37, strike "5.", "6.", "7.", and "8.", respectively, and substitute "4.", "5.", "6.", and "7.", respectively.

On page 14, in lines 6 and 12, strike "9." and "10.", respectively, and substitute "8." and "9.", respectively.

On page 15, in lines 1 and 8, strike "11." and "12.", respectively, and substitute "10." and "11.", respectively.
