AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1597

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "unless" in line 7 down through "determination" in line 8 and substitute "<u>under certain circumstances</u>"; and strike beginning with "repealing" in line 8 down through "certificates;" in line 10.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 7, 8, 9, 18, 19, 20, and 28, in each instance, strike the bracket; in line 9, strike "(B)"; strike in their entirety lines 12 through 15, inclusive; in line 16, strike the first opening bracket; in the same line, strike the first closing bracket; in the same line, strike "(2)"; strike beginning with "IF" in line 16 down through "CRIME," in line 17 and substitute "EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION,"; in line 18, strike "THE"; in line 20, strike "(I)"; strike beginning with the comma in line 21 down through "CERTIFICATE" in line 27; and in line 28, strike "(II)".

On page 3, in lines 1 and 15, in each instance, strike the bracket; and after line 15, insert:

- "(F) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A CONVICTION OF A CRIME FOR WHICH REGISTRATION ON THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY IS REQUIRED UNDER TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 7 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (2) If a period of 10 years or more has passed since an applicant completed serving the sentence for a crime, including all imprisonment, mandatory supervision, probation, and parole, and the applicant has not been charged with another crime other than a

MINOR TRAFFIC VIOLATION, AS DEFINED IN § 10–101 OF THIS ARTICLE, DURING THAT TIME, A DEPARTMENT MAY NOT DENY AN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE TO THE APPLICANT SOLELY ON THE BASIS THAT THE APPLICANT WAS PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF THE CRIME.".
