## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Delegate Luedtke" and substitute "<u>Delegates Luedtke, Hettleman, Tarlau, Lierman, Queen, Valentino–Smith, Jones, Sydnor, Lisanti, A. Miller, Korman, K. Young, Krimm, Morhaim, and Jackson</u>"; in line 9, strike "certain number of"; and in lines 9 and 10, strike "programs in certain locations" and substitute "<u>program</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 17, strike "or"; and in line 18, after "Health;" insert "OR

# (III) <u>THE JUVENILE SERVICES EDUCATION COUNTY PILOT</u> <u>PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT;</u>".

On page 3, in lines 5 and 6, strike "**DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES**" and substitute "**JUVENILE SERVICES EDUCATION COUNTY PILOT PROGRAM IN** <u>THE DEPARTMENT</u>".

On page 4, in line 1, strike "**UP TO THREE**" and substitute "<u>**ONE**</u>"; and in line 2, strike beginning with "**PROGRAMS**" through "**COUNTY**" and substitute "<u>**PROGRAM**</u>".

On page 5, in line 6, strike "and"; and in line 7, after "group" insert ";

(11) <u>a superintendent of a local public school system in the State, or the</u> <u>superintendent's designee; and</u>

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(12) <u>a member of a county board of education</u>".

On page 6, in line 4, after "staffing" insert "<u>, curriculum</u>,"; in line 5, strike "and"; and in line 7, after "options" insert "<u>; and</u>

(8) how to eliminate disparities in course offerings, staffing, and budgetary support available to students in the Juvenile Services Education System and to students served by public schools in the State".
