AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 728
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, strike “or transporting a battery operated smoke alarm into the State”; in line 5, strike “use” and substitute “purpose”; in line 6, before “defining” insert “imposing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act;”; and in line 10, after “9–101” insert “and 9–109”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, strike beginning with “**OR**” in line 6 down through “**STATE**” in line 7; and in line 7, strike “**CONSUMER USE**” and substitute “**COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 9, insert:

“9–109.

(a) A person may not knowingly violate this subtitle.

(b) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 10 days or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both.

(2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 9–106.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.”.
