AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "authorizing" in line 3 down through "requirements;" in line 16; in line 17, after "Incentive" insert "Pilot"; and in line 31, strike the first "the" and substitute "a certain".

On page 2, in line 5, strike "certain provisions of"; in lines 5 and 6, strike "altering certain definitions;"; in line 6, after "terms;" insert "providing for the termination of this Act;"; in the same line, strike "alterations to the" and substitute "a pilot program for"; in line 7, strike "process"; and strike in their entirety lines 8 through 12, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 through 7, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 21 on page 2 through line 13 on page 7, inclusive.

On page 7, in line 22, after "INCENTIVE" insert "PILOT"; and after line 28, insert:

"(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN:

- (1) HARFORD COUNTY;
- (2) PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY; AND
- (3) WASHINGTON COUNTY.".

On page 9, in lines 1, 9, 15, and 20, strike "(G)", "(H)", "(I)", and "(J)", respectively, and substitute "(H)", "(I)", "(J)", and "(K)", respectively; in line 11, after "COSTS" insert "FOR THE APPROPRIATE TYPE OF SCHOOL"; in line 12, strike "(G)" and substitute "(H)"; in line 13, strike "(F)" and substitute "(G)"; in line 15, strike "(J)" and substitute "(K)"; in the same line, after "SECTION," insert "§ 2–303(F) OF THIS ARTICLE,"; in line 16, after "SUBTITLE" insert a comma; and in line 22, strike "(H)" and substitute "(I)".

On page 10, in line 5, strike "(K)" and substitute "(L)"; and in line 10, after "2018." insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2023, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
