AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1518 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Morales" and substitute "<u>Morales</u>, <u>Pendergrass</u>, Cullison, Hill, Kipke, Krebs, Metzgar, Miele, Morgan, Pena-Melnyk, <u>Platt, Rosenberg, Saab, Sample-Hughes, Szeliga, West, and K. Young</u>"; in line 2, strike "Committee" and substitute "<u>Program – Report and Stakeholder Meetings</u>"; strike beginning with "Maternal" in line 3 down through "term" in line 14 and substitute "<u>Secretary of Health to include a certain summary of certain meetings in a certain report; requiring the Secretary to convene certain meetings of certain stakeholders at least a certain number of times each year; requiring certain meetings to be held within certain time periods and for certain purposes"; in line 15, strike "Committee" and substitute "<u>Program</u>"; in line 18, strike "13–1201" and substitute "<u>13–1207</u>"; and in line 23, strike "13–1206.1" and substitute "<u>13–1208</u>".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 14, strike "Committee and support of the Action Task Force" and substitute "<u>Program</u>".

On pages 2 through 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 21 on page 2 through line 2 on page 5, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>13–1207.</u>

(A) On or before December 1 of each year, the Secretary shall submit a report on findings, recommendations, and Program actions to the Governor and, subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly. (B) THE SECRETARY SHALL INCLUDE IN THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION A SUMMARY OF ANY STAKEHOLDER MEETINGS HELD UNDER § 13–1208 OF THIS SUBTITLE DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 12–MONTH PERIOD THAT INCLUDES:

(1) STAKEHOLDER RESPONSES TO EXISTING RECOMMENDATIONS; AND

(2) <u>Recommendations from stakeholders that address</u> <u>FACTORS CONTRIBUTING TO MATERNAL MORTALITY.</u>

<u>13–1208.</u>

(A) <u>AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR, THE SECRETARY SHALL CONVENE A</u> <u>MEETING OF STAKEHOLDERS, INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES OF:</u>

(1) <u>THE MARYLAND OFFICE OF MINORITY HEALTH AND HEALTH</u> <u>DISPARITIES;</u>

- (2) THE MARYLAND PATIENT SAFETY CENTER;
- (3) THE MARYLAND HEAD START PROGRAM;
- (4) WOMEN'S HEALTH ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS;

(5) COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS ENGAGED IN MATERNAL HEALTH AND FAMILY SUPPORT ISSUES;

(6) FAMILIES THAT HAVE EXPERIENCED A MATERNAL DEATH;

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(7) LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS; AND

(8) HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS THAT PROVIDE MATERNAL HEALTH SERVICES.

(B) OF THE TWO MEETINGS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION:

(1) ONE MEETING SHALL BE HELD WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER SUBMISSION OF THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER § 13–1207 OF THIS SUBTITLE TO:

(I) <u>REVIEW THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS IN THE</u> <u>REPORT;</u>

(II) EXAMINE ISSUES RESULTING IN DISPARITIES IN MATERNAL DEATHS;

(III) <u>REVIEW THE STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION OF</u> <u>PREVIOUS RECOMMENDATIONS; AND</u>

(IV) IDENTIFY NEW RECOMMENDATIONS WITH A FOCUS ON INITIATIVES TO ADDRESS ISSUES RESULTING IN DISPARITIES IN MATERNAL DEATHS; AND

(2) ONE MEETING SHALL BE HELD WITHIN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE MEETING HELD UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO REVIEW THE STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION OF PREVIOUS RECOMMENDATIONS AND CONSIDER ANY NEW
