# AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 728

(Third Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, strike "or transporting a battery operated smoke alarm into the State"; in line 5, strike "use" and substitute "<u>purpose</u>"; in line 6, before "defining" insert "<u>imposing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act;</u>"; and in line 10, after "9–101" insert "<u>and 9–109</u>".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, strike beginning with "OR" in line 6 down through "STATE" in line 7; and in line 7, strike "CONSUMER USE" and substitute "COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 9, insert:

### "9–109.

- (a) A person may not knowingly violate this subtitle.
- (b) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 10 days or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both.
- (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 9–106.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000."
