# AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 309, AS AMENDED (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

In the Finance Committee Amendments (SB0309/457277/1), in lines 1 and 2 of Amendment No. 1, strike "<u>requiring, to the extent practicable</u>,".

On page 1 of the bill, in line 3, before "emergency" insert "<u>authorizing</u>"; and in line 10, after "prosecution;" insert "<u>stating the intent of the General Assembly regarding</u> the reporting of certain information under certain circumstances;".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

In the Finance Committee Amendments, strike Amendment No. 2 in its entirety.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 6 of the bill, after line 10, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, unless overdose information is otherwise reported through the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems as required under Section 1 of this Act, it is the intent of the General Assembly that emergency medical service providers and law enforcement officers report, to the extent possible, overdose information via an appropriate information technology platform with secure access for the purpose of making decisions regarding the allocation of public health and educational resources.";

and in line 11, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
