1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – Hours of Sale – References to Park**
3 **Heights Redevelopment Area**

4 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from hours of sale restrictions for certain alcoholic
5 beverages licenses issued for establishments in a certain area in Baltimore City;
6 repealing certain references to the “Park Heights Redevelopment Area”; making this
7 Act an emergency measure; providing for the effective date of certain provisions of
8 this Act; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Baltimore City.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 7 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

9 12–102.

10 This title applies only in Baltimore City.

11 12–2005.

12 (c) **(1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:**

13 **(I) A CLASS B BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE;**

14 **(II) A CLASS B BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE;**

15 **(III) A CLASS C BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE; AND**

16 **(IV) A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.**

17 **(2)** For a license holder in an area bounded by Liberty Heights Avenue,
 18 Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue, the hours of sale:

19 **[(1)] (I)** may not begin before 9 a.m. or end after ~~9 p.m.~~ **10 P.M.**; and

20 **[(2)] (II)** may not be extended if they begin later than 9 a.m. or end before
 21 ~~9 p.m.~~ **10 P.M.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
 23 as follows:

24 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

25 12–2003.

26 (a) (1) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class A
 27 beer and light wine license may sell beer and light wine:

1 (i) on Monday through Saturday:

2 1. from 9 a.m. to ~~midnight~~ ***10 P.M.*** in the [Park Heights
3 Redevelopment Area that is] AREA specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
4 the City in 2006; and

5 2. from 6 a.m. to midnight in all other locations in the City;
6 and

7 (ii) on the Sundays that fall between Thanksgiving Day and New
8 Year's Day, from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., if, on or before September 30 of that year, the license
9 holder has paid a supplementary license fee of \$75 for each Sunday the privilege is to be
10 exercised.

11 (2) In addition to the privileges specified under paragraph (1)(ii) of this
12 subsection, the license holder may sell beer and light wine for off-premises consumption on
13 two additional Sundays during the calendar year if the holder pays a license fee of \$75 at
14 least 2 weeks before each time the privilege is exercised.

15 (b) (1) Except as provided in § 12-2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class B
16 beer and light wine license may sell beer and light wine:

17 (i) from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in the [Park Heights
18 Redevelopment Area that is] AREA specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
19 the City in 2006; and

20 (ii) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in
21 the City.

22 (2) Except as provided in § 12-2005 of this subtitle and § 12-903(d) of this
23 title, the license holder may sell beer and light wine at a bar or counter on Sunday.

24 (c) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a holder of a Class C beer
25 and light wine license may sell beer and light wine:

26 (i) from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in the [Park Heights
27 Redevelopment Area that is] AREA specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
28 the City in 2006; and

29 (ii) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in
30 the City.

31 (2) Except as provided in § 12-2005 of this subtitle, the license holder may
32 sell beer and light wine at a bar or counter on Sunday.

1 (d) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class D beer and
2 light wine license may sell beer and light wine:

3 (1) from 9 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day in the [Park Heights
4 Redevelopment Area that is] AREA specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
5 the City in 2006; and

6 (2) from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day in all other locations in the City.
7 12–2004.

8 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a holder of a Class A beer,
9 wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

10 (i) on Monday through Saturday:

11 1. from 9 a.m. to ~~midnight~~ **10 P.M.** in the [Park Heights
12 Redevelopment Area that is] AREA specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
13 the City in 2006; and

14 2. from 6 a.m. to midnight in all other locations in the City;
15 and

16 (ii) on the Sundays that fall between Thanksgiving Day and New
17 Year's Day, from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., if, on or before September 30 of that year, the license
18 holder has paid a supplementary license fee of \$75 for each Sunday the privilege is to be
19 exercised.

20 (2) In addition to the privileges specified under paragraph (1)(ii) of this
21 subsection, the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor for off–premises consumption
22 on two additional Sundays during the calendar year if the holder pays a license fee of \$75
23 at least 2 weeks before each time the privilege is exercised.

24 (b) (1) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class B
25 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

26 (i) from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in the [Park Heights
27 Redevelopment Area that is] AREA specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
28 the City in 2006; and

29 (ii) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in
30 the City.

31 (2) In the 47th alcoholic beverages district in the City, the hours for sales
32 of beer, wine, and liquor for off–premises consumption under a Class B beer, wine, and
33 liquor license for use in a restaurant are as provided in § 12–903(d) of this title.

1 (3) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle and § 12–903(d) of this
2 title, the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor at a bar or counter on Sunday.

3 (c) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class B–D–7
4 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

5 (1) from 9 a.m. to ~~2 a.m. the following day~~ ***10 P.M.*** in the [Park Heights
6 Redevelopment Area that is] **AREA** specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
7 the City in 2006; and

8 (2) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in the City.

9 (d) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a holder of a Class C beer,
10 wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

11 (i) from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in the [Park Heights
12 Redevelopment Area that is] **AREA** specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
13 the City in 2006; and

14 (ii) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in
15 the City.

16 (2) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle and § 12–903 of this
17 title, the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor at a bar or counter on Sunday.

18 (e) A holder of a Class D beer, wine, and liquor amusement permit may sell all
19 alcoholic beverages at all hours except between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. each day.

20 (f) (1) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class D
21 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor on Monday through Saturday:

22 (i) from 9 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day in the [Park Heights
23 Redevelopment Area that is] **AREA** specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
24 the City in 2006; and

25 (ii) from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day in all other locations in
26 the City.

27 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection and § 12–2007(b)
28 of this subtitle, the license holder may not exercise the privileges of the license without an
29 amusement permit from 1 a.m. on Sunday to 6 a.m. the following day.

30 (3) (i) The Board may issue a supplemental license not more than four
31 times during a calendar year to the license holder authorizing the license holder to sell
32 beer, wine, and liquor from 6 a.m. on Sunday to 1 a.m. the following day.

1 (ii) The fee for the supplemental license is \$75 per issuance and is in
2 addition to the annual fee for the underlying Class D beer, wine, and liquor license.

3 (iii) A holder of a supplemental license shall notify the Board at least
4 2 weeks in advance of exercising the privileges under the supplemental license.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take
6 effect July 1, 2018.

7 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
8 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
9 been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
10 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and, except as provided in Section 3 of
11 this Act, shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
