1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County Board of Education – Nonstudent ~~Members~~ Member**
3 **Compensation and Student Member Scholarships**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the amount of compensation of the nonstudent members of the
5 Baltimore County Board of Education; altering the amount a student member of the
6 Board is granted for a certain scholarship; providing for the application of this Act;
7 and generally relating to ~~the amount of compensation of the nonstudent members of~~
8 the Baltimore County Board of Education.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 3–2B–06.

18 (a) (1) Each nonstudent member of the county board is entitled to receive
19 **[\$100] \$7,500** annually as compensation.

1 (2) A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall
2 be granted a scholarship of ~~\$100~~ **\$1,000** to be applied toward the student's higher
3 education costs.

4 (b) After submitting vouchers under the regulations adopted by the county board,
5 a member is entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided for in the
6 Baltimore County budget.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35
8 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary
9 or compensation of the nonstudent members or the scholarship amount for the student
10 members of the Baltimore County Board of Education while serving in a term of office
11 beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
12 salary or compensation of the nonstudent members and the scholarship amount for the
13 student members of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall take effect at the
14 beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual
15 appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2018.
