## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Per Diem Beer License Fee**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the fee for a Class C per diem beer license in St. Mary's County;  
4 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in St. Mary's County.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

6 Article – Alcoholic Beverages  
7 Section 28–102 and 28–1309(c)  
8 Annotated Code of Maryland

10 BY repealing

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

23 28–102.

24 This title applies only in St. Mary's County.

2 (c) The period for which a license under this section may be issued is:

3 (1) for a Class C per diem beer license, not longer than 10 days;

4 (2) for a Class C per diem beer and wine license, 1 day; and

5 (3) for a Class C per diem beer, wine, and liquor license, 1 day.

6 [28-1310.

7 The fee for a Class C per diem beer license, a Class C per diem beer and wine license,  
8 and a Class C per diem beer, wine, and liquor license is \$10 per day.]

10 **THE LICENSE FEES UNDER THIS PART ARE:**

11 **(1) FOR A CLASS C PER DIEM BEER LICENSE, \$10 PER PERIOD FOR**  
12 **WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED;**

13 **(2) FOR A CLASS C PER DIEM BEER AND WINE LICENSE, \$10 PER DAY;**  
14 **AND**

15 **(3) FOR A CLASS C PER DIEM BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE, \$10**  
16 **PER DAY.**

17 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July**  
18 **1, 2018.**
