1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Asset Transfer for Magnetic Levitation**
3 **Transportation System – Municipal Agreements**

4 **PG 401–18**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring Prince George's County, before the transfer of an asset of the
6 county as part of the development of a magnetic levitation transportation system, to
7 negotiate a certain written agreement with a certain municipality under certain
8 circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the development of
9 a magnetic levitation transportation system in Prince George's County.

12 Section 12–413
13 Annotated Code of Maryland

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Local Government**

18 **12–413.**

19 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**
20 **INDICATED.**

21 **(2) “ASSET” INCLUDES:**

22 **(I) REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY; AND**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(II) ACCESS TO OR USE OF REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY.**

2 **(3) "TRANSFER" INCLUDES A SALE, A LEASE, A CONVEYANCE, A GIFT,**
3 **A PLEDGE, AN ENCUMBRANCE, OR A TRADE.**

4 **(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.**

5 **(C) BEFORE THE COUNTY TRANSFERS AN ASSET OF THE COUNTY THAT IS**
6 **LOCATED IN A MUNICIPALITY AS PART OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MAGNETIC**
7 **LEVITATION TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM THAT PASSES THROUGH THE COUNTY, THE**
8 **COUNTY SHALL NEGOTIATE A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH THE MUNICIPALITY**
9 **CONCERNING:**

10 **(1) THE APPROVAL BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TRANSFER; AND**

11 **(2) THE SHARING WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANY FINANCIAL**
12 **REMUNERATION THE COUNTY RECEIVES UNDER THE TRANSFER.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2018.
