A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Kent County – Orphans' Court Judges – Compensation

- FOR the purpose of establishing that a judge of the Orphans' Court for Kent County shall
 receive a salary set by the Kent County Commissioners; establishing that each judge
 shall receive an allowance for travel expenses in accordance with the county budget;
 requiring the County Commissioners to pay the travel allowance in a certain
 manner; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the
 Orphans' Court for Kent County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Estates and Trusts

17 2–108.

18 (p) (1) Each of the judges of the Court for Kent County shall receive [an annual 19 compensation of \$4,000. Each judge shall also receive an allowance for traveling expenses 20 of \$520 annually, to be paid quarterly by the County Commissioners] A SALARY AS SET 21 BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

22(2)(1)EACH JUDGE SHALL RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE FOR TRAVEL23EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COUNTY BUDGET.



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1 (II) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL PAY QUARTERLY TO 2 EACH JUDGE THE TRAVEL ALLOWANCE PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS 3 PARAGRAPH.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary $\mathbf{5}$ or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court for Kent County while serving in a term 6 7of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of a judge of the Orphans' Court for Kent County 8 9 shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does 10 not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out 11 an unexpired term.

12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2018.
