## Education – Family Life and Human Sexuality Curriculum – Boundaries and Consent

- 2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "CONSENT" MEANS <u>THE</u> UNAMBIGUOUS AND 3 VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN ALL PARTICIPANTS <del>TO ENGAGE</del> IN EACH PHYSICAL ACT WITHIN THE COURSE OF <del>SEXUAL ACTIVITY</del> <u>INTERPERSONAL</u> 5 RELATIONSHIPS, INCLUDING RESPECT FOR PERSONAL BOUNDARIES.
- 6 (B) BEGINNING IN THE 2018–2019 SCHOOL YEAR, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL
