- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to refund a prorated amount of a vehicle registration fee for each full month remaining in the registration period on surrender of the registration card and plates if the registration card and plates are returned within a certain number of months before the registration expires; altering the period of time within which a registration card and plate may be returned to the Administration for a refund of the registration fee; and generally relating to the refund of vehicle registration fees.

- (d) The Administration shall refund [the registration fees upon] ONE-TWELFTH OF THE ANNUAL AMOUNT OF THE REGISTRATION FEE FOR EACH FULL MONTH REMAINING IN THE REGISTRATION PERIOD ON surrender of the registration card and registration plates if the return is made [before the beginning of any 12-month registration year for which the application for refund is made] AT LEAST 3 MONTHS BEFORE THE REGISTRATION EXPIRES.
- 9 (e) The Administration may adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this 10 section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
