## 2 Education - Child Care Subsidies - Mandatory Funding Levels

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include in the State budget a certain appropriation to the Child Care Subsidy Program each fiscal year; requiring the Governor to appropriate <u>certain</u> funds in the State budget to increase the Child Care Subsidy Program reimbursement rates to a certain amount in certain fiscal years; and generally relating to the Child Care Subsidy Program.

- 21 (2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021, NOT LESS THAN THE 45TH PERCENTILE
- 22 OF THE MOST RECENT MARKET RATE SURVEY OR ITS EQUIVALENT IF AN
- 23 ALTERNATIVE METHODOLOGY DEFINED BY THE DEPARTMENT IS USED; AND
- 24 (3) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER,
- 25 NOT LESS THAN THE 60TH PERCENTILE OF THE MOST RECENT MARKET RATE
- 26 SURVEY OR ITS EQUIVALENT IF AN ALTERNATIVE METHODOLOGY DEFINED BY THE
- 27 DEPARTMENT IS USED.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 29 1, 2018.
