EXCEPT FOR CAPITAL FUNDING FOR MARYLAND INDEPENDENT 13 **(E)** COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND MEDICAL 14 SYSTEM, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE STATE 15 SHALL PROVIDE HBIS 35% OF THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT RESOURCES THAT ARE 16 17 ALLOCATED TO **INSTITUTIONS** \mathbf{OF} HIGHER **EDUCATION FOR CAPITAL** IMPROVEMENTS, WHETHER PROVIDED THROUGH THE CAPITAL BUDGET OR BY 18 19 PAY-AS-YOU-GO OPERATING FUNDING.
