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State Department of Education - Translation Grant Program - Established

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Translation Grant Program in the State Department 4 of Education; establishing the purpose of the Program; requiring the Department to 5 develop the Program; requiring the Program to be a competitive grant program; 6 requiring the Department to establish certain application procedures for obtaining a 7 grant under the Program; requiring the Department to award certain grants in a 8 certain priority; requiring the Department to distribute grants to be used for the 9 translation of certain educational materials and to supervise the use of grant funds; 10 requiring the Department to provide a grant to a certain county board in a certain 11 fiscal year under certain circumstances; requiring the Governor to include a certain 12 appropriation to the Program in each annual budget submission beginning in a 13 certain fiscal year; requiring a certain county board to distribute a certain grant 14 under the Program using a certain priority to schools within the county; requiring 15 certain county boards to submit a certain report to the Department every 2 years 16 beginning on or before a certain date; requiring the Department to report to the 17 Governor and the General Assembly every 2 years beginning on or before a certain 18 date; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations to implement the 19 Program; defining certain terms; and generally relating to grants to county boards 20 to support the translation of educational materials.
