13 Preamble

WHEREAS, Too often, students enrolled in institutions of higher education do not appreciate the value of their higher education experiences and, following a brief history of poor and failing grades, such students decide to pursue interests outside the academic world; and

WHEREAS, Following a considerable passage of time, former students have a greater appreciation of higher educational opportunities and may seek to return to the institution only to find that the grades they acquired during their earlier experience act as a barrier and hindrance to their academic progress; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of this section is to provide a mechanism for institutions of higher education to disregard the records of such students that prevent or impede their academic success; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 13 EDUCATION THAT RECEIVES STATE FUNDS SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN
