A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Community Colleges – Veterans Advisors and Veterans Resource Centers –**
3 **Established**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain community colleges to employ a veterans advisor to
5 provide enrollment and advising services to certain students and to establish a
6 veterans resource center; and generally relating to veterans advisors and veterans
7 resource centers at community colleges.

10 Section 16–109

11 Annotated Code of Maryland

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 **16–109.**

17 **EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL:**

18 **(1) EMPLOY AT LEAST ONE FULL–TIME VETERANS ADVISOR TO**
19 **PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE AND INTENSIVE ENROLLMENT AND ADVISING SERVICES**
20 **TO CURRENT AND PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS WHO ARE VETERANS; AND**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



- 1 **(2) ESTABLISH A VETERANS RESOURCE CENTER ON CAMPUS TO:**
- 2 **(I) PROVIDE ACCESS TO FEDERAL AND STATE VETERANS**
3 **RESOURCES;**
- 4 **(II) SERVE AS A QUIET PLACE FOR VETERANS TO STUDY;**
- 5 **(III) ENABLE VETERANS TO CONNECT TO OTHER VETERANS,**
6 **HELPING THEM RENEW THE BONDS OF MILITARY SERVICE; AND**
- 7 **(IV) BE THE CENTRAL HUB FOR ALL ACTIVITIES ON CAMPUS**
8 **RELATED TO VETERANS.**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2018.
