- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
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Article – General Provisions

19 3–305.

20 (b) Subject to subsection (d) of this section, a public body may meet in closed 21 session or adjourn an open session to a closed session only to:

(13) comply with a specific constitutional, statutory, or judicially imposed
 requirement that prevents public disclosures about a particular proceeding or matter; [or]

20(III) DEPLOYMENTS OR IMPLEMENTATION OF SECURITY21PERSONNEL, CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE, OR SECURITY DEVICES.
