2 **Allegany County – Orphans’ Court Judges – Pension Formula**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the number of years of service that may be used as a
4 multiplier in a formula to determine the pension provided an Orphans’ Court judge

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (y) (6) In Allegany County, the pension for an Orphans’ Court judge shall be
4 the greater of:

5 (i) \$1,200 annually; or

6 (ii) 1. Except as provided in item 2 of this subparagraph, an
7 annual amount calculated at the rate of 4 percent of the last annual amount of
8 compensation multiplied by the number of years of service, not exceeding [16] 24 years; or

9 2. An annual amount equal to two–thirds of the last annual
10 amount of compensation if the judge has more than 16 years of service.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to
12 apply only prospectively to an individual who retires on or after the effective date of this Act
13 and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any individual
14 who retires before the effective date of this Act.

15 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 ~~October~~ July 1, 2018.
