Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Class A-7 License

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City to issue a Class A-7 beer, wine, and liquor license; establishing that the license 4 5 authorizes the holder to sell alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption 7 days 6 a week during certain hours; providing that license holders who hold a certain class 7 of license are eligible to exchange that license for a Class A-7 license under certain circumstances; specifying that in a certain legislative district a Class B-D-7 license 8 9 may be exchanged for a Class A-7 license only under certain circumstances; 10 providing that a Class A-7 license can be issued only until a certain date; 11 establishing an annual license fee for a Class A-7 license; providing that the issuance, transfer, or renewal of a Class A-7 license is complete without certain 12 zoning approval or verification: and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses 13 in Baltimore City. 14

- 29 (D) A HOLDER OF A CLASS A-7 LICENSE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR

- 31 (E) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.

3	the issuance or transfer of a license within 45 days of receipt of the application to determine
4	whether the application is complete.
5	(2) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, an application
6	for the issuance, transfer, or renewal is not complete unless the applicant has:
7	(i) obtained zoning approval or verification of zoning if the
8	application is for renewal;
9	(ii) submitted all documents required in the application; and
10	(iii) paid all fines and fees that are due.
11	(3) (1) An application for the issuance, transfer, or renewal of a Class
12	B-D-7 license that may be issued under § 12-1603(e)(6) of this title in the Old Gouche
13	Revitalization District under § 12-1603(e) of this title is complete without an applican
14	obtaining zoning approval or verification of zoning.
15	(II) AN APPLICATION FOR THE ISSUANCE, TRANSFER, OF
16	RENEWAL OF A CLASS A-7 LICENSE THAT MAY BE ISSUED UNDER § 12-902.1 OF THIS
17	TITLE IS COMPLETE WITHOUT AN APPLICANT OBTAINING ZONING APPROVAL OF
18	VERIFICATION OF ZONING.
