4 FOR the purpose of altering the requirements for advertising public hearings on the
5 adoption of proposed alterations to regulations by the Board of License
6 Commissioners for Harford County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in
7 Harford County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

2 This title applies only in Harford County.

3 22-209.

4 (a) The Board may adopt regulations to carry out this article.

5 (b) (1) The Board shall hold public hearings on all proposed alterations of its
6 regulations.

7 (2) The hearings shall be advertised at least 2 consecutive weeks before the
8 scheduled public hearings [in at least two newspapers of general circulation in the county]:

9 (I) IN AT LEAST ONE NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION
10 PUBLISHED IN THE COUNTY; AND

11 (II) ON THE WEBSITE OF THE BOARD.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
13 1, 2018.
