- FOR the purpose of altering the purpose and use of the State Lakes Protection and 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Restoration Fund; requiring the Governor, beginning in a certain fiscal year, to 6 include in the annual budget bill a certain appropriation to the Fund; and generally 7 relating to the State Lakes Protection and Restoration Fund.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 18 19That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22In this section, "Fund" means the State Lakes Protection and Restoration (a) 23Fund.

24(b) There is a State Lakes Protection and Restoration Fund.

(2) Any interest earnings of the Fund shall be credited to the Fund.

3 (i) Expenditures from the Fund may be made only in accordance with the State 4 budget.

5 (j) Money expended from the Fund for the protection or restoration of 6 State-owned **OR STATE-OPERATED** lakes is supplemental to and is not intended to take 7 the place of funding that would otherwise be appropriated for the protection or restoration 8 of State-owned **OR STATE-OPERATED** lakes.

9 (K) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 10 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF 11 \$3,000,000 TO THE FUND.

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(a) The Department shall develop a working budget for the funds received from
the State Lakes Protection and Restoration Fund established under § 8–205 of this subtitle.

15 (b) The Department shall develop, in coordination with local governments, 16 organizations, and citizens, an annual work plan that prioritizes and details projects that 17 will receive funding from the State Lakes Protection and Restoration Fund.
