1 AN ACT concerning

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Transportation – Highway User Revenues – Distribution

3 FOR the purpose of altering the percentages of amounts of and process for appropriating 4 highway user revenues funds that are required to be distributed to Baltimore City, $\mathbf{5}$ counties, and municipalities in certain fiscal years; requiring that certain capital 6 highway grants may be made only under certain circumstances; altering the 7 percentages in requiring that in certain fiscal years of highway user revenues that 8 are required to be used as authorized under the Transportation Trust Fund; 9 repealing certain obsolete distributions and transfers of highway user revenues for 10 certain fiscal years; repealing certain obsolete distributions of highway user 11 revenues to Baltimore City, counties, and municipalities for certain fiscal years;
