- 12 (A) (1) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING
- 13 **MEMBERS:**
- 14 (I) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED
- 15 BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- 16 (II) FOUR MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,
- 17 APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; AND
- 18 (III) THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE
- 19 **GOVERNOR:**

- 5 6. ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A PROFESSIONAL
- 6 ORGANIZATION FOR SCHOOL NURSES IN THE STATE;
- 7. ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF AN ADVOCACY AND
- 8 SUPPORT GROUP FOR INDIVIDUALS AFFECTED BY PANDAS AND PANS;
- 9 8. ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF AN ADVOCACY AND
- 10 SUPPORT GROUP FOR INDIVIDUALS AFFECTED BY AUTISM; AND
- 9. One parent of a child who has been diagnosed
- 12 WITH PANDAS, PANS, AND AUTISM.
- 13 (2) THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE,
- 14 SHALL SERVE AS AN EX OFFICIO MEMBER WITHOUT VOTING PRIVILEGES.
- 15 (3) A NONLEGISLATIVE MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL MUST
- 16 BE A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.
- 17 (B) (1) THE TERM OF A LEGISLATIVE MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.
- 18 (2) THE TERM OF A NONLEGISLATIVE MEMBER IS 2 YEARS.
- 19 (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL
- 20 A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
- 21 (4) MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ARE ELIGIBLE FOR
- 22 REAPPOINTMENT.

- 24 (A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL IS A
- 25 QUORUM.
- 26 (B) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ELECT A CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR FROM
- 27 AMONG ITS LEGISLATIVE MEMBERS.
- 28 (C) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIR OR A

- 2 (D) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL:
- 3 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

- 9 (A) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL DEVELOP AND UPDATE AS NECESSARY 10 RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING:
- 11 (1) PRACTICE GUIDELINES FOR THE DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF PANDAS AND PANS;
- 13 (2) MECHANISMS TO INCREASE CLINICAL AWARENESS AND
- 14 EDUCATION REGARDING PANDAS AND PANS AMONG PHYSICIANS, INCLUDING
- 15 PEDIATRICIANS, SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS, AND PROVIDERS OF MENTAL
- 16 HEALTH SERVICES;
- 17 (3) OUTREACH TO EDUCATORS AND PARENTS TO INCREASE 18 AWARENESS OF PANDAS AND PANS; AND
- 19 (4) THE DEVELOPMENT OF A NETWORK OF VOLUNTEER EXPERTS ON
- 20 THE DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF PANDAS AND PANS TO ASSIST IN THE
- 21 DELIVERY OF EDUCATION AND OUTREACH.
- 22 (B) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, THE ADVISORY COUNCIL
- 23 SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246
- 24 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE
- 25 ADVISORY COUNCIL'S RECOMMENDATIONS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 27 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2021,
- 28 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and
- 29 of no further force and effect.
