produces not more than [27,500] 150,000 gallons of its own wine 1 (2)2 annually. 3 The license authorizes the license holder to sell and deliver NOT MORE (c) (1) 4 THAN 27,500 GALLONS OF its own brand of wine produced [at the license holder's 5 premises BY THE LICENSE HOLDER to: 6 (i) a holder of a retail license that is authorized to acquire the wine; 7 and 8 a holder of a permit that is authorized to acquire the wine. (ii) 9 The license holder may [not] sell its wine to a holder of a (2)(I)10 wholesaler's license. 11 (II) IF THE LICENSE HOLDER PRODUCES MORE THAN 27,500 12 GALLONS OF WINE IN A YEAR, THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL SELL THE AMOUNT OF WINE THAT EXCEEDS 27,500 GALLONS TO A HOLDER OF A WHOLESALER'S LICENSE. 13 14 (d) The annual license fee is \$50. 15 (e) The license holder may use an additional location for the warehousing, sale, and delivery of wine: 16 17 if approved by the Comptroller following submission of a separate (1) application for each location; and 18 19 (2) on the payment of a \$50 fee for each additional location. 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018. 21
