- 1 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE TO CONTINUE TO RECEIVE A SUBSIDY 2 UNDER THE PROGRAM:
- 3 (1) FOR UP TO 90 DAYS IN A YEAR IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS UNEMPLOYED 4 AND SEEKING EMPLOYMENT; AND
- 5 (2) If the individual meets any other eligibility criteria 6 determined by the Department.
- 7 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 8 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
