- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 (A) "FIRST RESPONDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED OR 17 CERTIFIED UNDER § 13–516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

18 (B) EACH FIRST RESPONDER IN THE STATE SHALL COMPLETE AUTISM 19 AWARENESS TRAINING APPROVED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND 20 STANDARDS COMMISSION.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2018.
