1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Home– and Community–Based Waiver Services – Prohibition on Denial

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Department of Health from denying an
individual access to a home- and community-based services waiver due to a lack of
funding for waiver services if the individual is discharged from a certain health care
facility directly to the individual's home and is eligible for certain funding within a
certain time period; and generally relating to home- and community-based waiver
services under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (a) The Department may not deny an individual access to a home- and 20 community-based services waiver due to a lack of funding for waiver services if:

21 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL IS DISCHARGED FROM A HOSPITAL DIRECTLY TO 22 THE INDIVIDUAL'S HOME AND WAIVER SERVICES FOR THE INDIVIDUAL ARE 23 ELIGIBLE TO BE PAID FOR BY THE PROGRAM WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER THE 24 DISCHARGE;



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1 (2) THE INDIVIDUAL IS DISCHARGED FROM A SKILLED NURSING 2 FACILITY OR REHABILITATION FACILITY DIRECTLY TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S HOME AND 3 WAIVER SERVICES FOR THE INDIVIDUAL ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE PAID FOR BY THE 4 PROGRAM WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER THE DISCHARGE; OR

5 [(1)] (3) (I) The individual is living in a nursing facility at the time of 6 the application for waiver services;

7 [(2)] (II) At least 30 consecutive days of the individual's nursing facility 8 stay are eligible to be paid for by the Program;

9 [(3)] (III) The individual meets all of the eligibility criteria for 10 participation in the home- and community-based services waiver; and

11 [(4)] (IV) The home- and community-based services provided to the 12 individual would qualify for federal matching funds.

13 (b) Nothing in this section is intended to result in a reduction of federal funds 14 available to the Department.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July16 1, 2018.
