1 AN ACT concerning

Public Institutions of Higher Education – Priority Registration for Members of the Armed Forces

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring public institutions of higher education to grant priority $\mathbf{5}$ registration for courses to certain currently serving members and veterans of the 6 armed forces of the United States; providing that a certain course registration 7 priority applies only within a certain period of time after an eligible service member 8 was on active duty; providing that a certain course registration priority does not 9 apply to an eligible service member after a certain number of academic years; 10 requiring public institutions of higher education to adopt certain policies; defining a 11 certain term; and generally relating to currently serving members and veterans of the armed forces of the United States and course registration in public institutions 12 13 of higher education.
