A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – County Superintendent of Schools – Postemployment**
3 **Compensation and Benefits**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain compensation and benefits provided to a certain
5 county superintendent to be commensurate with certain compensation and benefits
6 provided to certain professional personnel with the same tenure and vested benefits;
7 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the
8 postemployment compensation and benefits of the county superintendent of schools
9 in Calvert County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 4–202.

19 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each county
20 superintendent is entitled to the compensation set by the county board.

21 (2) In Prince George’s County, the Chief Executive Officer is entitled to the
22 compensation set by the contract with the county board.

23 (b) (1) The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during the
24 superintendent’s term of office.

1 (2) Each county superintendent shall devote full time to public school
2 business.

3 (c) In Anne Arundel County, the county board may not pay monetary
4 compensation to the county superintendent for sick leave benefits earned while employed
5 by any other board of education or public school system but may allow the county
6 superintendent to use the sick leave in the same manner as sick leave accrued while
7 employed by the county.

8 **(D) IN CALVERT COUNTY, ANY POSTEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION AND**
9 **BENEFITS PROVIDED TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL BE COMMENSURATE**
10 **WITH THE POSTEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS PROVIDED TO**
11 **PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL IN THE COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM WHO HAVE THE SAME**
12 **TENURE AND VESTED BENEFITS.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35
14 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary
15 or compensation of the County Superintendent of Calvert County while serving in a term
16 of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act
17 concerning the salary or compensation of the County Superintendent of Calvert County
18 shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does
19 not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out
20 an unexpired term.

21 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
22 1, 2018.
