- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "INAPPROPRIATE SEXUAL BEHAVIOR" HAS THE 18 MEANING STATED IN COMAR 10.01.18.02.
- 19 (B) A PRIVATELY OWNED AND OPERATED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT
- 20 CENTER SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY
- 21 THE DEPARTMENT UNDER COMAR 10.01.18.05 THAT APPLY WHEN A STAFF
- 22 MEMBER OBSERVES, RECEIVES A COMPLAINT REGARDING, OR OTHERWISE HAS
- 23 REASON TO BELIEVE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN SUBJECTED TO
- 24 INAPPROPRIATE SEXUAL BEHAVIOR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
