1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Registration – Exemption From Registration Fees – Surviving Spouses**  
3 **of Veterans**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that the surviving spouse of a deceased  
5 disabled veteran be at least 65 years old to qualify for a certain exemption to vehicle  
6 registration fees; and generally relating to vehicle registration fees.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
