CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Easements Foundation – Use of Land Signs, Billboards, and Outdoor Advertising Displays

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a landowner, without the approval of the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, to erect and display on land subject to 5 a certain easement a certain sign, billboard, or outdoor advertising display to be 6 7 erected, displayed, placed, or maintained on land subject to an agricultural land 8 preservation easement notwithstanding the terms of the easement for a certain 9 purpose; authorizing the Foundation to authorize a landowner to erect and display on land subject to a certain easement a certain sign or outdoor advertising display 10 for the purpose of providing certain information; providing that this Act supersedes 11 certain provisions of a certain deed or agreement; providing that this Act does not 12 supersede certain local laws or ordinances; providing for the application of this Act; 13 and generally relating to signs, billboards, and outdoor advertising displays on the 14 use of land subject to an agricultural land preservation easement. 15
