A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore–Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport – Security**
3 **Screening Checkpoint – Charitable Donations**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Executive Director of the Maryland Aviation
5 Administration to place donation boxes at the entrance to each security screening
6 checkpoint at the Baltimore–Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport;
7 requiring that money deposited in the donation boxes be appropriated for the benefit
8 of a certain program and be used to supplement, but not supplant, certain other
9 funds; defining certain terms; and generally relating to donation boxes and the
10 Baltimore–Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport.

12 Article – Transportation
13 Section 5–413.1
14 Annotated Code of Maryland
15 (2015 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

19 **5–413.1.**

20 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**
21 **INDICATED.**

22 **(2) “DONATION BOX” MEANS A CLEARLY MARKED RECEPTACLE FOR**
23 **THE CHARITABLE DONATION OF MONEY BY THE PUBLIC.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(3) “PROGRAM” MEANS THE RENTAL ALLOWANCE PROGRAM**
2 **ESTABLISHED UNDER § 4-1403 OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**
3 **ARTICLE.**

4 **(B) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL PLACE AND MAINTAIN DONATION**
5 **BOXES AT THE ENTRANCE TO EACH SECURITY SCREENING CHECKPOINT AT THE**
6 **BALTIMORE-WASHINGTON INTERNATIONAL THURGOOD MARSHALL AIRPORT.**

7 **(C) THE MONEY DEPOSITED IN THE DONATION BOXES REQUIRED UNDER**
8 **SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE:**

9 **(1) APPROPRIATED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PROGRAM; AND**

10 **(2) USED TO SUPPLEMENT, BUT NOT SUPPLANT, ANY OTHER**
11 **FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR THE PROGRAM.**

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2018.
