5 ~~City Police Department be used towards community policing under certain~~
6 ~~circumstances~~ requiring the Baltimore Police Department to submit a certain annual
7 report on certain funds received from the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and
8 Prevention; and generally relating to funds for the Baltimore ~~City~~ Police
9 Department.

12 Section 4–801 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 8. Baltimore ~~City Community~~

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Public Safety**

19 **SUBTITLE 8. BALTIMORE ~~CITY COMMUNITY POLICING~~ POLICE DEPARTMENT**
20 **FUNDS.**

7 (A) THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES ONLY TO EACH GRANT THE EXECUTIVE
8 DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION
9 MAKES TO THE BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

10 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBTITLE IS TO ENSURE THAT GRANTS FROM
11 THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION TO THE
12 BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR COMMUNITY POLICING EFFORTS ARE USED
13 FOR THAT PURPOSE.

14 (C) (1) IN FISCAL YEAR 2018, THE BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT
15 SHALL PREPARE A HALF-YEAR REPORT ON THE EXPENDITURE OF GRANTS
16 RECEIVED FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION.

17 (2) IN FISCAL YEAR 2019 AND IN EACH SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR,
18 THE BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL PREPARE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON
19 THE EXPENDITURE OF GRANTS RECEIVED FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF
20 CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION.

21 (D) THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION
22 SHALL INCLUDE:

23 (1) THE INTENDED USE OF EACH GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S
24 OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION TO THE BALTIMORE POLICE
25 DEPARTMENT; AND

26 (2) THE SPECIFIC EXPENDITURES MADE BY THE BALTIMORE POLICE
27 DEPARTMENT WITH ANY MONETARY GRANTS RECEIVED FROM THE GOVERNOR'S
28 OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION.

29 (E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 EACH YEAR, THE BALTIMORE POLICE
30 DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF
31 THIS SECTION TO THE BALTIMORE CITY DELEGATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,
32 IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2018.
