A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Temporary Registration – Out-of-State and Foreign Vehicles**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from driving or attempting to drive a vehicle in
4 the State with certain out-of-state or foreign temporary or temporary transporter
5 registrations that do not comply with the laws of the issuing jurisdiction;
6 establishing certain penalties for violations of this Act; and generally relating to
7 out-of-state and foreign temporary registrations.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That Section(s) 16–402(a)(16) through (42), respectively, of Article – Transportation of the
21 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 16–402(a)(17) through (43),
22 respectively.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
24 as follows:

25 **Article – Transportation**

2 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT DRIVE OR ATTEMPT TO DRIVE A VEHICLE IN THE
3 STATE THAT HAS AN OUT-OF-STATE OR FOREIGN TEMPORARY OR TEMPORARY
4 TRANSPORTER REGISTRATION THAT ON ISSUANCE WAS VALID FOR 90 DAYS OR
5 FEWER UNLESS THE REGISTRATION COMPLIES WITH THE LAWS OF THE ISSUING
6 JURISDICTION.

7 (B) A PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT
8 TO:

9 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500; OR

10 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE NOT
11 EXCEEDING \$1,000.

12 16-402.

13 (a) After the conviction of an individual for a violation of Title 2, Subtitle 5, §
14 2-209, § 3-211, or § 10-110 of the Criminal Law Article, or of the vehicle laws or regulations
15 of this State or of any local authority, points shall be assessed against the individual as of
16 the date of violation and as follows:

17 (16) ANY VIOLATION OF § 13-405.1 OF THIS ARTICLE.....3 POINTS

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2018.
