## A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class C License and Class C and D Per Diem Entertainment Venue License

### Ho. Co. 20-18

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of establishing a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license in Howard County; 6 specifying that the license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor 7 at retail for on-premises consumption at the place described in the license and for 8 off-premises sale and consumption under certain circumstances; authorizing beer, 9 wine, or liquor purchased on an adjacent licensed premises to be consumed on the 10 premises for which the Class C beer, wine, and liquor license is issued; providing for 11 the hours of sale; requiring the Board of License Commissioners to determine the 12annual license fee; establishing Class C and Class D per diem entertainment venue 13 beer, wine, and liquor licenses; specifying that the Class C and Class D per diem 14 entertainment venue beer, wine, and liquor licenses authorize the license holder to 15sell beer, wine, and liquor on an immediately adjacent licensed premises for consumption on the premises of the holder of the per diem license and on the adjacent 1617licensed premises; requiring the property owner of the adjacent licensed premises to 18 provide the Board with a statement authorizing the use of a licensed premises; 19requiring the Board to determine the per diem license fee; defining a certain term; 20and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Howard County.

9	(A) THERE IS A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
10 11	(B) (1) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL:
12 13	(I) FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE; AND

25	1. AT THE SAME TIME AS THE LICENSE HOLDER; AND

3 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ENTERTAINMENT VENUE" MEANS A FACILITY THAT 4 IS USED AS A CINEMA, THEATER, CONCERT HALL, OR SPORTS STADIUM.

5 (B) THERE IS A CLASS C PER DIEM ENTERTAINMENT VENUE BEER, WINE, 6 AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

7 (C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE CLASS C PER DIEM LICENSE TO THE 8 HOLDER OF A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN AN 9 ENTERTAINMENT VENUE THAT MEASURES AT LEAST 200,000 SQUARE FEET.

10 **(D)** THE CLASS C PER DIEM LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER 11 TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED 12 PREMISES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES OF THE HOLDER OF THE PER DIEM 13 LICENSE AND ON THE ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES.

14 (E) THE BOARD MAY NOT ISSUE THE PER DIEM LICENSE TO SELL BEER, 15 WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES FOR 16 CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES UNLESS THE PROPERTY OWNER OF THE 17 ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES PROVIDES THE BOARD WITH A STATEMENT 18 AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.

19 (F) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR MONDAY 20 THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 10 A.M. TO 11 P.M.

21 (G) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE LICENSE FEE.

22 **23–1314.** 

23 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ENTERTAINMENT VENUE" MEANS A FACILITY THAT 24 IS USED AS A CINEMA, THEATER, CONCERT HALL, OR SPORTS STADIUM.

25 (B) THERE IS A CLASS D PER DIEM ENTERTAINMENT VENUE BEER, WINE, 26 AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

27 (C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE CLASS D PER DIEM LICENSE TO THE 28 HOLDER OF A CLASS D BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN AN 29 ENTERTAINMENT VENUE THAT MEASURES AT LEAST **200,000** SQUARE FEET.

30 (D) THE CLASS D PER DIEM LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER

TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED
PREMISES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES OF THE HOLDER OF THE PER DIEM
LICENSE AND ON THE ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES.

4 (E) THE BOARD MAY NOT ISSUE THE PER DIEM LICENSE TO SELL BEER, 5 WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES FOR 6 CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES UNLESS THE PROPERTY OWNER OF THE 7 ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES PROVIDES THE BOARD WITH A STATEMENT 8 AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.

9 (F) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR MONDAY 10 THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 10 A.M. TO 11 P.M.

11 (G) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE LICENSE FEE.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 13 1, 2018.
