A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Highways – Maryland Route 208 – Jurisdiction**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State, on request by the Town of Brentwood, Prince
4 George's County, to assume ownership of a certain portion of Maryland Route 208
5 located in the Town of Brentwood.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

19 8–633.

20 Except as otherwise provided by law, the Administration does not have any duties,
21 responsibilities, or powers with respect to the construction, reconstruction, or maintenance
22 of any highways except State highways.

23 **8–634.**

1 **ON REQUEST BY THE TOWN OF BRENTWOOD, PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY,**
2 **THE STATE SHALL ASSUME OWNERSHIP OF MARYLAND ROUTE 208 FROM RHODE**
3 **ISLAND AVENUE TO THE BORDER OF THE TOWN OF BRENTWOOD AND THE CITY OF**
4 **HYATTSVILLE, PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2018.
