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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Special Event Zones – Worcester County**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in Worcester County the State Highway Administration,  
4 on its own initiative or at the request of a local authority, to designate an area on a  
5 State highway as a special event zone and reduce established speed limits in the  
6 special event zone after making a certain determination; authorizing a local  
7 authority to designate an area on a highway under its jurisdiction as a special event  
8 zone and reduce established speed limits in the special event zone after making a  
9 certain determination; providing that a speed limit established under this Act shall  
10 become effective when posted; prohibiting a person from driving a motor vehicle at a  
11 speed exceeding the posted speed limit within a special event zone; ~~prohibiting a~~  
12 ~~driver from committing certain violations while driving in a special event zone while~~  
13 ~~pedestrians are present; prohibiting a driver from committing a certain violation~~  
14 ~~that results in bodily injury or death to another person;~~ establishing certain  
15 penalties for certain violations of this Act; providing for the application of this Act;  
16 defining certain terms; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally  
17 relating to highway special event zones.

 11 under the laws of this State, has authority to enact laws and adopt local police regulations  
 12 relating to traffic.

~~(i) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH; AND~~

~~(ii) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.~~

~~(2) A PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.~~

~~(3) A PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
