A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Stadium Authority – Use of State Owned or Leased Suite – Disclosure**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to report to the Maryland Stadium Authority
4 the name of each person who received a ticket to attend an event or meal in a suite
5 owned or leased by the State in a State owned or leased stadium, the date of the
6 event, the nature of the event, and certain information regarding amounts paid or
7 reimbursed to the State within a certain time period; requiring the Authority to post
8 a certain statement on the Authority’s website; and generally relating to the use of
9 State owned or leased suites and disclosure.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Economic Development**

18 **10–612.1.**

19 **(A) WITHIN 15 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE CLOSE OF EACH CALENDAR**
20 **QUARTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL REPORT TO THE AUTHORITY:**

21 **(1) THE NAME OF EACH PERSON WHO RECEIVED A TICKET TO ATTEND**
22 **AN EVENT OR MEAL IN A SUITE OWNED OR LEASED BY THE STATE IN A STATE OWNED**
23 **OR LEASED STADIUM IN THE PRECEDING CALENDAR QUARTER;**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



- 1 **(2) THE DATE OF THE EVENT;**
- 2 **(3) THE NATURE OF THE EVENT; AND**
- 3 **(4) ANY AMOUNT THAT THE PERSON PAID OR REIMBURSED THE**
4 **STATE FOR:**
- 5 **(I) A TICKET TO THE EVENT; OR**
- 6 **(II) FOOD OR BEVERAGES PROVIDED TO THE PERSON AT THE**
7 **EVENT.**
- 8 **(B) THE AUTHORITY SHALL POST A STATEMENT FILED UNDER SUBSECTION**
9 **(A) OF THIS SECTION PROMPTLY ON THE AUTHORITY'S WEBSITE.**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2018.
